



### **Isotrading REACH statement:**

Legal reference: Regulation n° 1907/2006/EU and n° 1272/2008/EU of the EU Parliament.

- The purpose of the Reach regulation is to limit imports of articles releasing SVHC (substances of very high concern that are carcinogenic and/or mutagenic and/or toxic for reproduction).
- Isotrading does not manufacture electronic components, therefore the declaration of SVHCs remains the responsibility of the component manufacturer.
- Very few electronic components are affected by the Reach regulation. But there are exceptions and therefore the Reach status is verified by Isotrading before any customer offer.
- Isotrading is considered an "importer" in the EU and the registration for importers of SVHCs is mandatory from one ton imported per regulated substance (in components and their packaging).
- Isotrading notifies its customers of the presence of SVHCs in articles imported if the threshold concentration of 0.1% mass/mass (m/m) declared by the manufacturer is exceeded.

### **Isotrading ROHS statement:**

Legal reference: Directive 2011/65/EU of the EU Parliament on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, updated with Directive 2017/2102/EU of the EU Parliament.

- The purpose of the Rohs regulation is to limit imports of hazardous substances in articles releasing substances.
- Isotrading does not manufacture electronic components, therefore the declaration of hazardous substances remains the responsibility of the component manufacturer.
- All electronic components (passive, active or electromechanical) must comply with the Rohs regulation and their status is verified before any customer offer.
